**PASTORAL COORDINATOR'S CORNER**

**DIOCESAN DEVELOPMENT FUND**

For the last few years, Holy Family has not been aware of the role of the **Diocesan Development Fund (DDF)**. What has happened is that the goal had been taken out of the funds that were on deposit and no campaign was undertaken to involve the parishioners in this necessary and worthy undertaking. The **DDF** is the way by which the Diocese funds various ministries that respond to our call – as Catholics – to fill people’s lives with hope. This hope is for all of the people of the Diocese and includes Holy Family. We hope that there are more vocations – we pray for them every Sunday in our intentions – and we need to provide places for the training of those who are called to a life of service to their brothers and sisters. We hope that people who grieve can be comforted and we offer programs to help them restore the hope in their lives that they once had. We hope that the hungry are fed and we can provide for them through our pantry and those of other parishes. But ours is a call to serve all of the brothers and sisters in the Church of San Bernardino. We are called upon to help all those in need of hope in the two counties of San Bernardino and Riverside.

Each of us could volunteer to provide these services directly but, since we cannot be in all places at every moment of need, we can assist our sisters and brothers through others who minister in the name of the Church. They rely on us to provide support for their ministries and we ought to do no less than what Christ told us we would be judged upon – see Matthew 25: 34-46.
