Pastoral Reflection:

This is the culmination of the stories of Resurrection. Jesus enters the locked room and show His crucified and risen body to the frightened disciples. This is what the power of the Spirit is given for the world. Into our fear, Jesus comes with the word we need to hear: Peace be with you. They come not as words we earn, but as words we need so we can proclaim the good news of Easter to the world.
