PASTORAL COORDINATOR'S CORNER

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY

Today, the Church in the U.S. takes time to celebrate all those who teach the faith to others - our Catechists.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "You cannot live your faith if you do not know it, and you cannot share with others what you do not first make your own" (CCC 429). It is through the dedication of those who teach that we first learned of our faith. In a very real sense our first catechists were our parents and those in our families who taught us something about God that we have carried with us throughout our lives.

Nowadays, it seems that we rely more and more on our volunteers who teach in the parish's faith formation programs. To them, we owe a great deal of gratitude. They ensure that our faith is "handed on" (a phrase which we get from the Latin word 'tradition' which literally means to give over and from which we get the word tradition) as we have received it from those who handed it over to us.

Get to know some of the catechists at Holy Family by attending a class with your child. See what they are learning. Instead of dropping them off and picking them up, try to sit with them as they go to class. In this way, you are teaching them how important religion is to you. We are always teaching our children and sometimes we use words.

Our catechists consider it a great responsibility to be entrusted by you with the faith formation of the children of Holy Family. They do not think that they are replacing your vital function in 'handing over' the faith to your children. Please give thanks to our catechists who show by their stewardship of time and talent how seriously they take the responsibility of teaching the faith to those who follow us.

Consider on this Catechetical Sunday your role in the education of your children in the faith we share in Christ Jesus, Our Lord. Parents are the first teachers of their children with respect to the faith - may we also be the best of teachers. - *Deacon Vic*

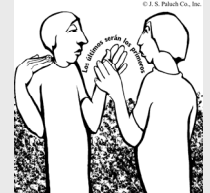

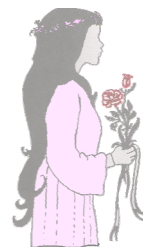

La matricula es un documento de identificación aceptada por distintas instituciones en los Estados Unidos. Para obtener una o renovar la anterior de FONDO ROJO, usted debe traer al Consulado los siguientes documentos:

- 1. ACTA DE NACIMIENTO ORIGINAL**
- 2. UNA IDENTIFICACIÓN OFICIAL VIGENTE CON FOTOGRAFÍA**
- 3. UN COMPROBANTE DE DOMICILIO A NOMBRE DEL INTERESADO.** Ejemplo: Recibo de Pago de un servicio como luz, teléfono, gas; ó talón de pago; ó talón de pago; ó una carta a su nombre y con su dirección, etc.
- 4. Las señoras casadas;** deben presentar adicionalmente el original del acta de matrimonio civil si desean el apellido del esposo en su matrícula.
- 5. Los menores de edad** deberán acudir acompañados de sus padres.
- 6. Todos los documentos deben presentarse en original y una copia.**
