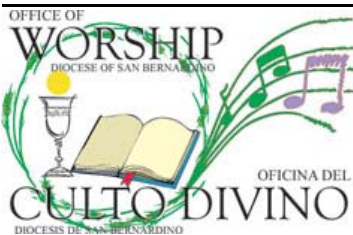

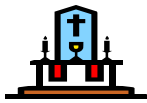

Letters Needed in Support of a Catholic High School in the High Desert Vicariate!

A handful of parents, a high school building committee and myself have been working on this project for several years now. I am now pleading for the assistance of the rest of you. I have already met with the committees of the Diocese and I was told that there must be considerable interest from the community and the parishes of the Vicariate in order for Bishop Barnes to give his blessing. I have in my possession the original surveys "of need" sent out to all the parishes and the school families at the beginning of last year, but it is not enough. **I need you to write a letter of support for the establishment of a Catholic High School on this campus, so that we can move forward.** Bennett Lord, the architect, is working on the plans which include the placement of the temporary classrooms (portable building), as well as the construction of the permanent two story buildings, which include science labs, technology center, and art and music rooms. I have asked him to provide me with a portfolio that I can share with you. It is time to really get this done! The high school needs to be up and running by September 2007. Your support is tremendously needed. Thank you!
